1. Job Title: Tenure-track Assistant Professor, 1 post (After the tenure-track term, a candidate who has passed the review process will be granted tenure along with promotion to associate professor)
2. Affiliation: Department of Earth and Planetary Sciences, Faculty of Science
3. Research Field: Geology/Geochemistry  
We seek a young researcher who will be able to promote geological and geochemical studies on the evolution of the Solar System, Earth's environment, and life on Earth thorough time. Research areas could include (but are not limited to) geochemistry, cosmochemistry, and chemostratigraphy of sedimentary rocks. Applicants should be highly interested in conducting interdisciplinary studies in collaboration with various researchers in our department and other related research institutes to advance solid Earth sciences. The candidate is expected to develop and maintain a vigorous externally funded research program and to teach at the undergraduate and graduate levels.
4. Qualification Requirements:
  - (1) Having a doctoral degree by the time the appointment begins.
  - (2) Possible to actively participate in education in undergraduate and graduate courses.
  - (3) Possible to supervise and teach undergraduate and graduate students.
  - (4) Possible to work on the operations of the department and the university.
5. Appointment date: As soon as possible on or after April 1, 2022
6. Tenure-track term: until March 31, 2027  
Intermediate evaluation and final tenure review will be conducted in the third and fifth year, respectively. The tenure review will be made mainly based on research activity including interdisciplinary and international joint research, educational activity and research grants awarded during the tenure-track term. A candidate receiving satisfactory evaluation will be granted tenure along with promotion to associate professor.

  - (3) Summary of your research activities (2 page limit)
