The Graduate School of Science offers two distinct education programs: The Front Researcher Program (FR) and The Advanced Scientist Program (AS). These programs are designed to cultivate human resources aligned with evolving needs of science and society in the 21st century. Students enrolled in the Graduate School of Science must belong to one of these programs.

The core activities begin with forming your own supervisor's team and conducting research activities according to your plan through regular communication with the team. At the end of the fiscal year, you are expected to prepare a report on your research results and submit it to your supervisor. If approved by your supervisor, submit the report to the Office for FR&AS Programs (W1-A-305). This report will serve as the basis for evaluating your performance. We also offer an English Presentation course as part of the program, which you can participate in upon your request.
